4:00-5:00: Dramatic Play: Beginning Theater

pre-k to k \$195, class code DP01

Students learn the fundamentals of theater and acting skills through games, role playing and acting exercises. Ends in a combined class musical performance.

4:30-5:30: Mini Players: Intro to Acting

Grades 1-2 \$195, class code: MP02

Basic theater class using role-playing, skits, music, movement and games. Designed for the beginner, this class encourages children to explore creative movement and play in an expressive and imaginative setting. Ends in a class combined class musical.

5:40-6:40: Playmakers: Beginning Musical Theater

Grades: 2-3 \$195, Class code: PM03

Students will learn both beginning singing and acting techniques for musical theater along with basic theater movement. Ends in a combined class musical performance.

6:45-8:15: Center Stage: Theater Acting

Grades 3-6 \$295, class code: CS04

Designed for students who are interested in focusing more on acting technique rather than musical theater. Students will expand their knowledge of acting and theater and will be introduced to monologues, audition techniques, improv and stage craft. Ends in a class performance.
